When you have a concern in the workplace...your

Collective Agreement and your Shop Steward are your first point of contact. Tom Davis, the Vice-President and Chief Shop Steward will be advised of all workplace concerns by the shop stewards, but he must often rely on the CUPE shop steward to handle queries and early meetings. Della Kerfont, the Full Time Officer, has been responding to most queries and many, many Stage 1 meetings, but her focus must at this time be with larger and pending issues that require meetings with Senior Management. Therefore, please adopt the following procedure regarding your concerns:

- 1) Obtain a copy of the current Collective Agreement (in PDF form on the intranet). The Collective Agreement contains the principles and rules that both the employer and CUPE have agreed to adhere to.
- 2) If you determine that you definitely have a concern, you need to speak with a shop steward, or, preferably, the shop steward in your work area about your concern. The Shop Steward's role is to gather all of the facts surrounding your concern or management's concern and to be present when CUPE employees are requested or required to meet with management regarding one's work, job description or behaviour in the workplace.
- 3) If you do not know the shop steward for your work area, or a shop steward from a different work area, please call the CUPE office at 780.791.3411.
